Recital time is approaching so please be sure to read this important newsletter about all that is going on. Mark your calendars with all the dates and times! Many of the questions we receive can be answered in this newsletter, so please keep it.



Tickets will go on sale April 15<sup>th</sup> at 7 AM. Seats for the show will NOT be general admission. All seats will be assigned, but you will have a choice on where you would like to sit. Friday night and Saturday matinee tickets can be purchased through www.tututix.com/americandanceacademy or by calling 855-222-2TIX. Ticket prices are \$18 to \$22 (plus processing fees) depending on the seating area chosen.

There is no minimum or maximum number of tickets to purchase. You will need a credit or debit card to buy tickets, and tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis. So, buy early to get better seats! Tickets will not be sold at the door but will be available for online purchase up to the time of the event, if still available.

You'll have several options for how you want your ticket delivered. You can have it emailed to you, sent to your mobile phone internet browser, and even add it to your Apple Wallet at no charge! Or, you can choose to have TutuTix mail you foilembossed keepsake tickets for an additional fee— with your dancer's name printed directly on the ticket!

# **Recital Update** RECITAL COSTUMES

Costume distribution is through the month of March. The Recital Costume Instruction & Shoes/Tight List will be added to the Recital Info section of the website. All tights are to be either Capezio Ballet Pink (BPK) or Capezio Light Suntan (LSN). If you would like a tan tight (ballet must be pink) that better matches your dancer's skin tone please find another color in the Capezio style number that is provided. We only stock the light suntan color as it matches best with our jazz and tap shoes. Please check all costumes as soon as you receive them and call within one week to report any discrepancies. Costumes will not be given out to children whose accounts are not paid to date! Once accounts are paid to date, the costumes will be given.



### **RECITAL INFO**

### Important Information will be added to the "News" page of our website and put in a Recital Section.

All dancers will report to an assigned dressing room on the Dress Rehearsal and Show nights. Dancers in PS1, PS2, Kinderdance, and those only in a Hip Hop Ages 5-6 class will be picked up during intermission. Following their dance, they will return to the dressing room or wait for the "Little Finale" depending on when they perform in the show. They are to be picked up during intermission and can either leave or watch the second half. If watching the second half, they can either sit on a parent's lap or have a ticket purchased to have their own seat.

Nobody is permitted in the dressing rooms during the show unless they have a Stage Mom badge in order to keep congestion to a minimum and for safety purposes. We ask that one female drop off and pick up the dancer before and after the show. No men are allowed in our girls dressing room areas as older girls are changing. We will have a separate changing area for boys who have costume changes.

### CLASS STAGE MOM SIGN UPS

MOMS - we need your help for recital week! Sign-Ups will be done online through Sign Up Genius. An email with sign up link will be sent out on April 5th. There will be a stage mom Zoom meeting on May 7th from 7:30-8:15 pm. Stage moms help the dancers backstage with costume changes and help to line the dancers up and walk them backstage when our backstage managers tells them it's time. (Sorry Dads - we can only use you in the boy's dressing room.) All stage parents are to report to the last class before the recital. REMEMBER - NO OTHER PARENTS WILL BE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE WHEN THE SHOW IS GOING ON IN ORDER TO KEEP CONGESTION TO A MINIMUM!!! A badge will be given to each stage parent to distinguish them. <u>These stage parents will be required to be at all the rehearsals with the students</u>.

\* Stage moms are <u>not</u> babysitters on Dry Run – parents must stay with their children or ask another parent to watch them.

## RECITAL WEEK

As the season progresses, excitement is building for our big production. Routines are being practiced and perfected. All classes are doing different dances, so at this time it is very important that your child attend his/her scheduled class each week. ALL REHEARSALS AND SHOW DATES ARE MANDATORY. REHEARSALS ARE JUST AS IMPORTANT AS THE SHOW NIGHTS AND THEY ALLOW THE CHILDREN, THE STAFF, AND MYSELF TO FAMILIARIZE OURSELVES WITH THE SURROUNDINGS. Both rehearsals and recital dates are at <u>St. Mark's High School</u> located at 2501 Pike Creed Road, Wilmington, DE 19808. **REMINDER:** the studio will be closed this entire week. Please be sure to purchase any tights/shoes you may need from us before this week!

#### Monday, May 12th - No classes & No rehearsals

#### Tuesday, May 13th - DRY RUN

No costumes. Students will wear their regular dance attire in black (pink OR tan tights permitted). Hip Hop & Pom dancers should wear ALL black. Everyone is to wear the proper shoes. A half hour time slot will be allotted per a number of dances between the hours of 4:30 pm and 8:30 pm. I will try my best to remain on schedule. Parents must stay with their children. Children must remain seated, no running around. They will be called up by class.

### Wednesday, May 14th - DRESS REHEARSAL

ADMISSION WILL BE WITH WRISTBAND <u>ONLY</u>. Wristbands will be given with final information sheet-one per family. Extras can be purchased at the same price as a ticket. Stage moms do not need a ticket as their wristband will allow them access. All students will report at 5:30 pm dressed in their first costume to their designated dressing room. This rehearsal is like the show night and will be THE <u>ONLY</u> NIGHT THAT PICTURES AND VIDEOS WILL BE ALLOWED!!!

#### Thursday, May 15th - No classes & No rehearsals

#### Friday, May 16th - SHOW at 6:30

Dancers report to dressing room in costume by 6:00 pm for line up. Dressing rooms open at 5:30 pm.

#### Saturday, May 17th - SHOW at 1:00

Dancers report to dressing room in costume by 12:30 pm for line up. Dressing rooms open at 12:00 pm.
